Lately I am playing with subversion and I am using it at work for such documents (only internal) with apache. The basic setup allows that your last version is always accessible through HTTP and for those wanting more (and having proper clearance), svn access allows diffing and log examining. Yes, I know there is the Recent Changes at the top of each document, but sometimes it is too broad. On the other hand my suggestion might be an overkill.
